



Accident or Crime?

Reconstruction

- Crash Reconstruction
 - How/why did the crash happen
- DRE Reconstruction
 - How was the driver impaired
- Case Reconstruction
 - Rebuilding the entire case



State vs Pedro Ferman

- Single vehicle crash
- Defendant suffers SBI
- Passenger(wife) dies







Issues

- Investigators pushed "accident" not crash
- No interview of defendant
 - Or surviving passenger
- No vehicle inspection or recon
- How could a crash like this happen?
- Was this even a crime?

How do we get there?

- Interview the defendant
 - At hospital and at station
 - polygraph
- Vehicle inspection
 - Lexus / Toyota acceleration issues?
 - Lexus engineer flew out from California to inspect the brake and accelerator

How do we get there?

- Crash reconstruction
 - 60 mph crash in a parking lot
- Fiesta video
 - Complainant in the store
 - Complainant getting into car no seatbelt
 - Car pulling away, pushing a vehicle out of his way
- Witness statements
 - 2 constables watched entire crash

Answers


- Argument with wife over \$\$
- Video of her getting into car just prior to crash
- Defendant tells wife "we are all going to die" moments before crash
- Defendant planned on leaving country day after with crash with child – and without wife

Pedro Ferman



- Charged with Murder
- Pled to lesser offense of Crim Neg Homicide











































Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus

- It's the most reliable SFST
- Only three of the seven drug categories cause
 HGN
- The HGN test MUST be done correctly to be effective followed up by VGN
- Officers need to know how to testify about HGN









DRE Reconstruction

 By definition, a DRE Reconstruction is the post-incident process of collecting, analyzing, and interpreting evidence in order to reconstruct the subject's state of sobriety at the time of the incident.

DRE Reconstruction

- Mostly for fatal crashes
- Experienced DRE's only
- Recon will put the pieces together when a crash investigation is lacking, or unable to be complete from the beginning
- Used to link the evidence together

State vs Sarah Brannon

- April 11, 2013
- Brannon was a wrong way driver on US 59 downtown Houston
- Stuck and killed Cynthia Hunter in a head on crash at 60 mph
- Brannon was critically injured and not expected to survive her injuries

But she lived....

WHAT DO WE DO NOW???

DRE Reconstruction

- Find a DRE and start sucking up
- Collect offense reports, photos, toxicology reports, crash reconstruction, videos, witness statements, medical records... and anything else available
- DO NOT EXPECT MIRACLES if there is no evidence, there is no recon
- This is not a rush job.. Give it a little time

State vs Sarah Brannon


- Brannon had 6 different drugs, 4 categories, in her system at the time of the crash
- Brannon pled guilty and a PSI was held in November 2015.
- Sentenced to 12 years TDCJ
- The judge cited the DRE reconstruction multiple times as the reason for the sentence

- April 26, 2015
- Boudreaux was involved in 4 crashes in 2 ½ hours
- Two of those crashes were fatal







- Crash 1
 - 3:35pm in Medical Center area
 - Struck a vehicle that was stopped at red light
 - Issued a traffic ticket



- Crash 1
 - 3:35pm in Medical Center area
 - Struck a vehicle that was stopped at red light
 - Issued a traffic ticket
- Crash 2
 - 5:00pm in Midtown area
 - Witness stated that he was definitely "high"
 - Officer made contact but took no action
 - Released from scene at approximately 5:35pm




- Crash 3
 - Southeast Houston
 - Fatal hit and run
- Crash 4
 - East Houston
 - Ran red light striking vehicle, killing a 6 year old
 - Arrested and charged with intox manslaughter










- The 4 crashes helped develop a timeline
- Witness statements, Boudreaux recorded voice, crash video and tox report
- DWI charges were filed on the two crashes that the HPD officers failed to properly act
- The DRE reconstruction helped file 2 Intox Manslaughters, Intox Assault, FSRA causing death and 2 DWI's






- 1. Drink special

- 7. Chugs beer before leaves






















Jail Calls
