









Minnesota Roadway Fatalities







Metro Region Focus Areas 2010-2014*














2014 Fatalities*












2014 Serious Injuries*












5-year Progress in Fatalities












5-year Progress in Serious Injuries







Key Findings for 2014*

Metro Region

- Males ages 20-29 are overrepresented in serious injury and fatal crashes.
- 8.6 fatalities per month
- 38.5 serious injuries per month
- Alcohol and unbelted-related crashes are decreasing.





Key Findings for 2014*

Successes!

- 1 County with only FIVE fatalities
- 2 Counties with only TEN serious injuries
