ENHANCED GRADUATED DRIVERS LICENSE

- Effective 01/15/2015
- Each school <u>must</u> establish a schedule or procedure for providing "<u>Supplemental Parental Curriculum</u>" to any primary supervisor who <u>chooses</u> to receive it.
- Be at least <u>90 minutes</u> in length;
- Be <u>provided by or in the presence of</u> a driver education instructor
- Provide information on; graduated driver licensing, safety risks with novice drivers, influence of adults on driving behavior and provide additional resources.

WHAT WE DID TO PREPARE

- Invited all drivers education instructors in our district to meet and discuss the presentation and what it had to offer them and parents.
- Invited Gordy Pehrson from the Office of Traffic Safety to do a "Train the Trainer" session on the "Point of Impact" presentation. (free training - approximately 90 minutes).
- Each school chose its date(s) to present the "Point of Impact" presentation to the parents/teens.

PRESENTATION NIGHT

- Auditorium seating, sound system, view of presentation.
- Respectful of people's time.
- Information available to take with them Free (Department of Traffic Safety)
 - Teen driving rules
 - Moped/motorcycle rules
 - Fact sheets on teen driving statistics, etc.
- Had Certificates of Attendance <u>immediately available</u> at the end of presentation.
- Had Officers available to answer questions.
- Fall and Winter 80% of parents attended-----Spring 90% of parents. Hard to judge total numbers as many had two parents attend as well as child.

ROAD BLOCKS

- Not all schools have drivers education classes/instructors.
 - How to collaborate with private business driving schools.
- Whose job is it to collaborate with the school/businesses?
 - Liaison? Traffic Safety Officer? Community Policing Officer?
- Time and Date selection.
- If a private business wasn't to sponsor the event and have a table at the event is this an issue for your school?
- What to do if a parent cannot make your presentation but wants to attend another?
 - Will the neighboring city allow them?
