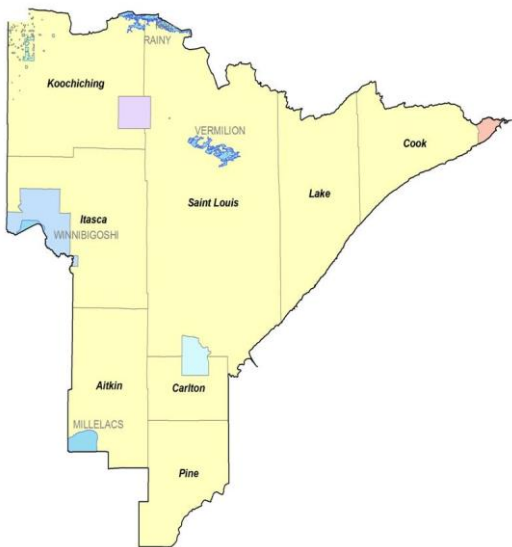


## Mission:

- ❖ Evidence-based approaches.

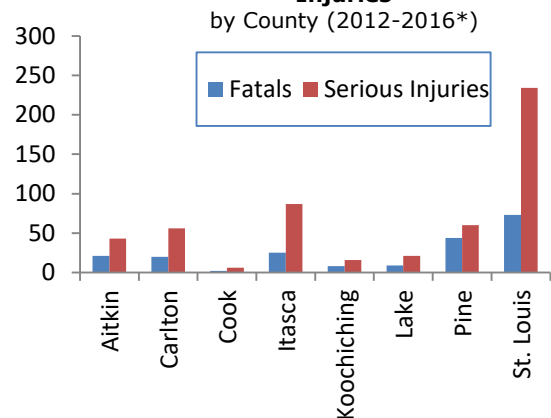


The Northeastern Minnesota Toward Zero Deaths (TZD) program began in 2010. The counties involved include: Aitkin, Carlton, Cook, Itasca, Koochiching, Lake, Pine and St. Louis.

The leading cause of deaths and severe injuries in Northeastern Minnesota include:

- ❖ **Alcohol**,
- ❖ **Distraction**,
- ❖ **Speed** and
- ❖ Lack of **Seatbelt** use.

### Northeastern Minnesota FATALS and Serious Injuries



The leading type of crash resulting in deaths and severe injuries include:

- ❖ **Run-off-Road**
- ❖ **Intersection-related**
