### **Traffic Safety...A Global Crisis**

- 1.3M per year killed, and 50M injured, on the world's roads
- Economic cost of \$100 billion a year
- By 2015, traffic crashes will be the leading cause of death or disability for children age 5 and above

#### A Comparison in the US.....

33,808 traffic fatalities in 2009 (FARS)

18,361 killed by homicide

3,443 died by drowning

1,816 died in airplane and water travel related accidents


#### **Overview National TZD Effort**

  - Safety partnerships have been strengthened
  - Greater leadership focus on safety
- ...But we still face significant challenges
  - 33,808 fatalities in 2009
  - Legislative and other barriers to implementing proven strategies






 Minnesota, along with Utah, Washington and West Virginia were earlier adopters





























# Comparison of Fatality Rate per VMT of Surrounding States, 2009 (total fatalities)
