










Northeast Lane Departure Crashes






- Teen and young adults (age 16 30)







Northeast Minnesota Key Findings

- Compared to 2016, fatalities and serious injuries were down in 2017
- o The "Big Four" remain a challenge
 - Impairment
 - Distraction
 - · Seat belt use
 - Speed
- Teens and young adults continue to be overrepresented in crashes
