- Cocaine Seizures and purchases 645 ounces
- Crack Cocaine 18.5 ounces
- Hashish 1222.5 ounces
- Heroin 720 ounces
- Marijuana 71,165 ounces
- Methamphetamine 10,571 ounces -up from 7901 (2016)
- Prescription Pills 215,305 dosage units 58,578 in 2016
- 12 Meth Labs statewide



HEROIN

- 2014-2015 Large Heroin investigations
 - Red Lake seizure of 5 pounds of heroin.
 - Beasley with 41 indictments.
 - February-March 2016 Rash of Fatal overdoses in Northern MN.
 - April 2016 BCA learns of COPS Anti-Heroin Grant
 - Based on primary treatment rates




DRUG OVERDOSE MORTALITY RATES






CY2007 Heroin SUD Treatment Admissions by County of Residence




CY2015 Heroin Substance Use Disorder Treatment Admissions by County of Residence





CY2016 Heroin Substance Use Disorder Treatment Admissions by County of Residence






