


### Southeast MN Fatalities, 2013-2017\*

### Southeast MN Serious Injuries, 2013-2017\*



Note: New injury definitions were introduced in MNCrash beginning in 2016 to align with national standard definitions.




# Statewide Fatalities and Serious Injuries






### Southeast Lane Departure Crashes






### Southeast Intersection Crashes

#### Who?


- Young adults (age 21 35)

## Speed-Related Target Audience

#### Who?

- Young adults (age 21 35)
- Men

#### When?

- Early morning and overnight
  (7 AM 9 AM; 10 PM 4 AM)
- Every day of the week












# Southeast Distraction-Related Fatalities and Serious Injuries





# Distraction-Related Target Audience


#### Who?

- All ages are about equally represented
- Distraction impacts both genders

#### When?

- Evenings (4PM 10PM)
- Weekdays (Monday Thursday)












# Southeast Unbelted Fatalities and Serious Injuries

#### Who?


- Adults (age 31—55)

### Population of Minnesota, 2015\*







## People Killed or Seriously Injured – Southeast Region 2013-2017\*






## MN Population and Southeast Region Crash Victims, 2013-2017\*













### Southeast Minnesota Key Findings

- Compared to 2016, fatalities and serious injuries were down in 2017
- The "Big Four" remain a challenge
  - Impairment
  - Distraction
  - Seat belt use
  - Speed
- Teens and young adults continue to be overrepresented in crashes
