Mayo Clinic and Local Partners

- In 2017, Mayo Clinic conducted 17 presentations/events in SE Minnesota
- The simulator was loaned out 26 times to traffic safety partners in Drivers Education, Public Health and TZD
- Together, a total of 2,238 teens and adults received education around safe driving through the presentation and the distracted driving simulator

2018 TZD Efforts

- In 2018, we conducted 7 presentations in Olmsted County
- Together, a total of 309 teens and adults received education around safe driving through a presentation and the distracted driving simulator


