To move West Central Minnesota toward **zero** deaths on our roads using education, enforcement, engineering and emergency medical and trauma services.







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Minnesota TZD: 10 years of Progress






Minnesota Traffic Safety Successes

- § Second lowest fatality rate in the U.S. in 2011
- § From 2008–2012 ...
 - § Fatalities decreased 13%
 - § Serious injuries decreased 18%
 - § Unbelted fatalities and serious injuries **decreased 30%**





After the Crash


To date, 99% of trauma admissions now occur at hospitals participating in the statewide trauma system.



Regional Seat Belt Use

- In 2012, the West Central regional seat belt compliance rate was remained at 77.3%
- Statewide, seatbelt compliance was at 93.6%
- North Dakota's compliance rate is 80.9%



While some counties have achieved "Zero Deaths" there are still more than 1,000 people severely injured each year on Minnesota roadways





Year-to-Date Traffic-Related Fatalities

As of Friday, May 17 there were **99** traffic-related deaths on Minnesota roads, compared to **96** deaths at this time last year.


