
2007 Operation NightCAP (nighttime concentrated alcohol patrol) Summer Metro DWI Enforcement

Metro-Area Enforcement Results:

Enhanced patrols began June 8

- 107 DWI arrests
- 622 traffic- and equipment-related violations
- 1,224 stopped vehicles
- 11 seized vehicles
- 17 underage drinking citations

Anoka, Dakota, Hennepin and Ramsey counties DWI background information:

- Statewide 2004–2006, there were 540 alcohol-related traffic deaths. Nearly 24 percent — 129 — of these deaths occurred in Anoka, Dakota, Hennepin and Ramsey counties. More than 46,000 DWI arrests occurred in these counties — nearly 41 percent of all Minnesota DWI arrests during that time period.
- Summertime enforcement will include around 4,700 hours of enhanced enforcement.
- In a similar metro NightCAP effort last year in Hennepin and Ramsey counties, NightCAP officers arrested 1,631 impaired drivers, cited 10,702 drivers for traffic- and equipment-related offenses and stopped more than 19,000 vehicles.
